# THE HOLY EUCHARIST with Spiritual Communion

Prelude

#### Lighting the Advent Wreath

Leader: "Today we light the first, second, and third candles of the Advent wreath. Each candle has a meaning. The first candle is HOPE, the second candle is PEACE, and the third candle — a pink candle — signifies JOY."

[Two purple candles and one pink candle are lit.]

Leader: Let us pray: "Gracious God, you came to us in human flesh and you abide with us in the Holy Spirit. Fill us with your joy, and help us shine as a light to the world. Through Jesus Christ, who makes our joy complete. Amen."

#### Opening Hymn 76 "On Jordan's Bank"

- 1 On Jordan's bank the Baptist's cry announces that the Lord is nigh; awake and hearken, for he brings glad tidings of the King of kings.
- 2 Then cleansed be every breast from sin; make straight the way for God within, and let each heart prepare a home where such a mighty guest may come.
- 3 For thou art our salvation, Lord, our refuge and our great reward; without thy grace we waste away like flowers that wither and decay.
- 4 To heal the sick stretch out thine hand, and bid the fallen sinner stand; shine forth, and let thy light restore earth's own true loveliness once more.

Celebrant: Blessed are you, holy and living One.

People: You come to your people and set them free.

- 1 When the Lord restored the fortunes of Zion, \* then were we like those who dream.
- 2 Then was our mouth filled with laughter, \* and our tongue with shouts of joy.
- 3 Then they said among the nations, \*
  "The Lord has done great things for them."
- 4 The Lord has done great things for us, \* and we are glad indeed.
- 5 Restore our fortunes, O Lord, \* like the watercourses of the Negev.
- 6 Those who sowed with tears \* will reap with songs of joy.
- 7 Those who go out weeping, carrying the seed, \* will come again with joy, shouldering their sheaves.

#### **Epistle**

A Reading from the First Letter to the Thessalonians. [1 Thessalonians 5:16-24] The Word of the Lord. [People: Thanks be to God.]

**Sequence Hymn 70** "Herald, Sound the Note of Judgement"

- 1 Herald, sound the note of judgment, warning us of right and wrong, turning us from sin and sadness till once more we sing the song.

  Chorus: Sound the trumpet! Tell the message: Christ, the Savior king, is come!
- 2 Herald, sound the note of gladness; tell the news that Christ is here; make a pathway through the desert for the one who brings God near.
- 3 Herald, sound the note of pardon--those repenting are forgiven; God receives his wayward children, and to them new life is given.
- 4 Herald, sound the note of triumph; Christ has come to share our life, Bringing God's own love and power, granting vict'ry in our strife.

#### The Nicene Creed

[358]

**W** e believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God,

eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made.

For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary, and was made man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son.

With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Let us confess our sins against God and our neighbor. Silence may be kept.

All: Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone.

We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves.

We are truly sorry and we humbly repent.

For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen.
